Laura's Garden will provide an inviting, community garden space. In addition to the physical garden, our organization seeks to promote accessible educational experiences through project-based learning. As a designated Pollinator Pathway, Laura's Garden is a corridor of native plants that provide nutrition and habitat for pollinating insects and birds.

Laura's Garden will be a quiet, contemplative space with flowering plants and trees, lots of sunshine and fluttering butterflies. It will be a place for parents to gather for a quiet moment while their children play, for community members to enjoy a reflective moment and for children to wonder at the joys of color, nature and butterflies. The garden will be built in the shape of a nautilus shell - a symbol of perfection and beauty, strength, spiritual growth, creation and movement. These symbols personify Laura.

Laura and her family loved spending their time together at the playground at Mikey's Place in Standish Park in Old Wethersfield. 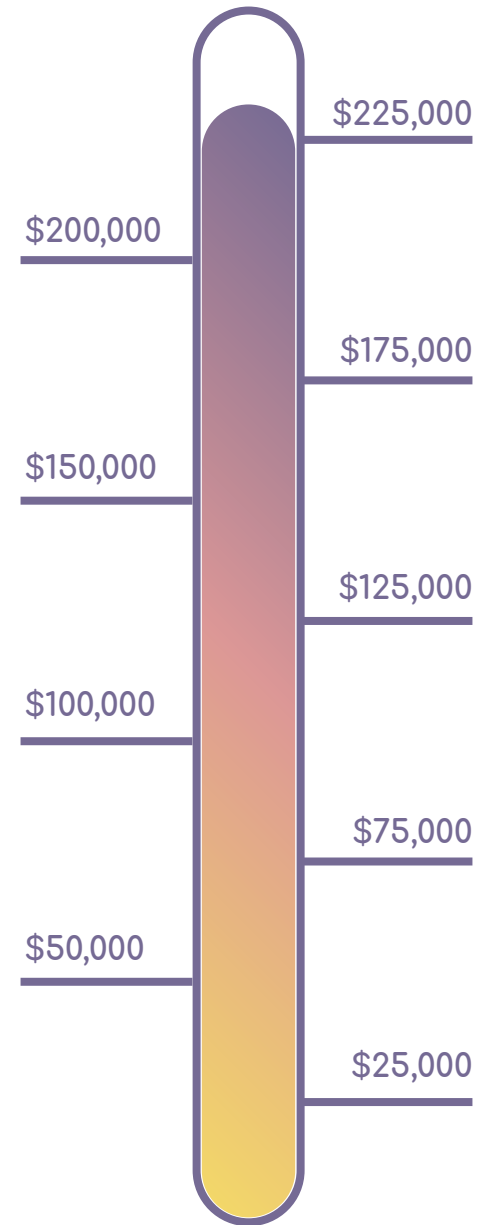
# OUR GOAL
